Major Duties Include:

- Provide oversight and consultation to the Occupational and Environmental Consultative section (OEC).
- Provide subject matter expertise to various project and program initiatives.
- Support OEC projects by assisting with investigations, analysis, plans, designs, implementation, and identification.
- Provide expert level support for issue resolutions and customer support.
- Provide support of the availability and usability of branch laboratories and the specialized equipment located therein.
- Assure specialized equipment maintains calibration and is accounted for according to AFRL/AFMC/AF instructions and is stored appropriately when not in use.
- Ensure cleanliness and organization of the laboratories.
- Support the day-to-day oversight of administrative actions pertaining to opening, closing, and maintaining work units and monitoring.

Position Requirements:

- Master's Degree in Health Physics and 5 years in the respective discipline • Certification as Certified Health Physicist CHPs.
