By completing this course, participants will gain hands-on experience through performance-based activities and the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively communicate climate and weather-related risks among the whole community.

Course Scope:

This course teaches effective communication of climate and weather-related risks, tailored to address community needs, recognize underserved populations and disadvantaged communities, and collaborate with trusted organizations.

Emergency managers, urban planners, state, local, tribal, and territorial government (SLTT) leadership, first responders, community-based organizations, economic development organizations, public health officials, councils of government, public information officers
