# HICS TRAINING PROGRAM

5-Levels of Training for World-Class Healthcare Preparedness

### Level 1: HICS Awareness Course

#### **Course Description**

This course introduces HICS for all levels of hospital staff regardless of role or responsibilities within the disaster response efforts. This course focuses on learning the framework of HICS and how it is applied during an incident. General medical staff will learn the key elements of implementing HICS.

## **Level 2: HICS Practical Application Course**

#### **Course Description**

This course provides an in-depth look into operational aspects of HICS during incident response. Medical staff must be fully aware of the various roles within the HICS, how HICS enables the management of incidents that expand in complexity, and how HICS practically works within the scope of each healthcare business unit's Emergency Operations Plan.

## Level 3: HICS - Designing & Implementing Effective Exercises

#### **Course Description**

Effective exercise design, development & implementation is critical to building disaster preparedness capacity for medical emergency responders. This course highlights the role of exercises in the preparedness system. This course equips participants with the knowledge, skills, resources, and best practices for designing, implementing & evaluating exercises to ensure continuous improvement.

## Level 4: Hazard Vulnerability Assessments (HVAs) for Hospitals

#### **Course Description**

HVAs help hospitals identify the hazards and risks that may lead to mass casualty incidents and disruptions to operations. This course will enable Disaster Links and Emergency Planners to conduct an HVA and apply the results in the hospital's Emergency Operations Plan and preparedness program.

### Level 5: Crisis Leadership & Decision Making for Healthcare Leaders

#### **Course Description**

This course is designed to equip crisis leaders with the skills and tools needed to recover quickly and preserve life, safety, health, and property. Topics include scene size-up, decision support tools and models, situational awareness, and best practices for countering the effects of stress on the leader.
